Samutkarsh Mahashivir : A historic event of Vidya Bharati Purvottar Kshetra

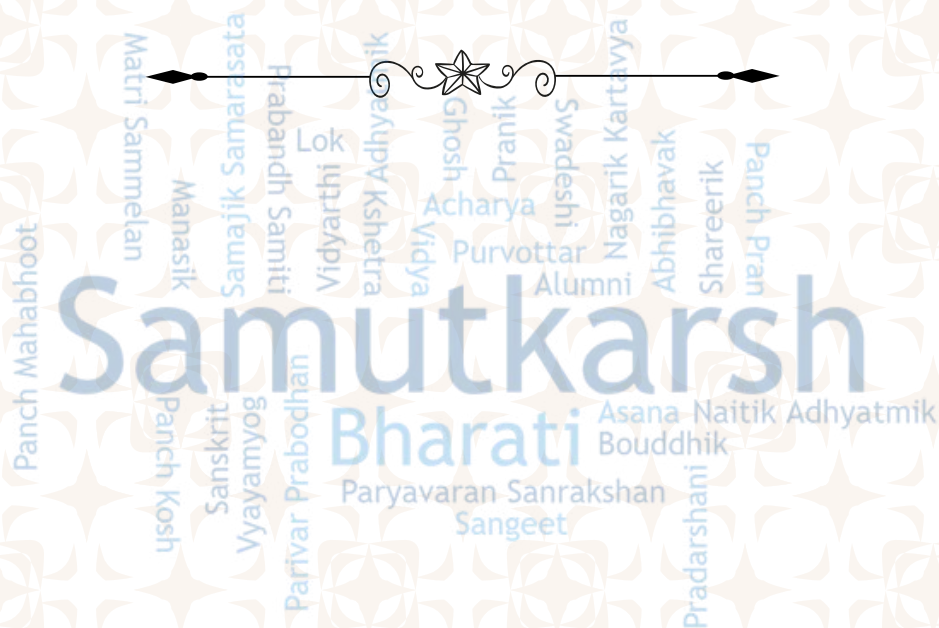

Guwahati NGO launches mega camp for student development through holistic approach
